All motives submitted will be reviewed and judged by an expert jury panel. The three convincing results will be rewarded. Furthermore the best results will be published with credits on this website. Take the challenge and demonstrate your skills and creativity!

How to participate

Follow these easy steps:

- 1. Register & choose your preferred HDR-package
- 2. Wait for the confirmation e-mail including a link to the selected HDR-package, download the data and get going.
- **3.** Submit your result(s) digitally no later than October 31st 2010.

What to win

Prizes:

1st prize: Full day custom HDR-shooting with Peggy Stein*

2nd prize: Full HDR-package** including back plates with exclusive rights of use without limitations regarding the time, the content or the area of use for commercial use
